

# DARTS Metropolitan Transportation Plan

Do you have concerns about transportation in your community?

Dougherty Area Regional Transportation Study (DARTS) is updating our Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), also known as a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).

## Why are we doing this update?

To ensure continued access to Federal and State transportation funding, the transportation planning process must be carried out every 5 years, for designated urbanized areas that exceed a population of 50,000, as well as the areas expected to become urbanized within the next 20 years.

## What will the Plan do?

DARTS is responsible for overseeing the planning process to ensure continued accessibility, connectivity, efficiency, mobility, and safety for the movement of people and goods.


DARTS will work with partner agencies, stakeholders, and the public, to:

- Identify transportation needs,
- define solutions,
- prioritize investments, and
- direct the flow of federal transportation funds accordingly.

## Purpose of the Project:

- Updated Goals, Objectives, and Transportation Priorities for the MPO region
- Gain community feedback to determine region-wide transportation desires
- Create a prioritized, cost-constrained list of projects to be implemented over the next 25 years

## Project Overview

The MTP covers at least a 20-year time-frame, in this case through the year 2045. DARTS' current LRTP (2040) was approved on December 3, 2014, and our five-year update is due October 4, 2019. The planning process will focus on updating goals, objectives, and transportation priorities for the MPO region. The project will result in a prioritized, cost-constrained list of projects that will be implemented by 2045, and a plan to guide the advancement of project implementation for the DARTS region.
