- Drivers are supplied with PPE
- Passengers are entering and exiting from the rear of the bus
- All transit rides are currently free
- Prescheduled Para trips on Saturday (dialysis and grocery shopping)
- Hand sanitizer supplied on all transit
- Encouraging passengers to stay at home

- Speed tables will be installed on West 3rd Ave

 Phase 3 of the resurfacing program will go before the Commission by the end of April

- Safety action plan will begin striping on May 4th
