Annual allocation of funds from the government FY 2021

Kerrie stated that we will ask the PO for additional funds to revise the following plans:

- \$100,000 Bike and Pedestrian Plan
- \$50,000 Freight profile
- We have hired an additional staff member (Tanner Anderson Planner I) slated to begin work on Monday, April 20, 2020.
- Performance based Metropolitan Plan in place

Followed by a brief discussion.

Operations during COVID 19 pandemic

Gwendolyn highlighted the current Transit COVID 19 safety operations until further notice:

- hired temporary workers to sanitize transit vehicles on an hourly basis.
- Safety barriers have been installed on transit buses
- Drivers are supplied with PPE
- Passengers are entering and exiting from the rear of the bus
- All transit rides are currently free
- Prescheduled Para trips on Saturday (dialysis and grocery shopping)
- Hand sanitizer supplied on all transit
- Encouraging passengers to stay at home

There are no current updates on the Transportation Center.

- Traffic signals at Gillionville and Westover are almost complete
- Connector trail almost complete
- Traffic signal at the Connector trail almost complete
- Speed tables will be installed on West 3rd Ave
- Phase 3 of the resurfacing program will go before the Commission by the end of April

Jeremy Brown - County

- Radium Springs project Phase 1 in progress
- Phase 2 of the Skywater project in progress
- Railroad improvements are expected to be completed by July
- Safety action plan will begin striping 20 miles of road on May 4th
- Concrete speed tables will be installed on River Point Drive.
